Food safety department officials sealed the canteen at a women's private arts college near Chathiram bus stand on Wednesday as 40 hostel students fell ill after consuming food supplied by the canteen.

Food for the students is supplied from the canteen functioning within the college campus. On Tuesday, 27 hostel students felt dizzy and vomited after having dosa for dinner. Subsequently, all of them were admitted to a private hospital at Singarathope. They were discharged on Wednesday.

Another 13 students were rushed to the hospital on Wednesday after they also developed dizziness and vomiting.

District food safety department has sealed the canteen citing violation of rules as it was not maintained in a hygienic way.
