Title:	30 Children fell sick after eating chicken meal in Chamarajanagar, Karnataka

An incident in Morarji Residential School of Yadavanahalli village of Gundlupet taluk in which children who ate chicken meal became sick due to vomiting and sickness took place on Sunday night. A total of 30 students are seriously ill and 15 are being treated at Begur hospital. Education department officials and police visited the hospital and inquired about the health of the children.

A few days ago, more than 30 students who had consumed hot food in a government school in Bidar were sick with vomiting and dysentery and were admitted to the hospital. The incident took place at a government high school in Nimbur village of Humanabad taluk. Initially, stomach pain, vomiting and dysentery were found in a few students. Later, the other students who went home were also sick with vomiting and dysentery. The children were immediately admitted to the hospital.
