35 students who ate lunch in a government school near Ariyalur suffered from vomiting and fainting. After that they got treated at Jayangondam Government Hospital and returned home.

### Ariyalur Vomiting-fainting

Adi Dravida Nala Primary School is functioning in Gangaikonda Cholapuram village near Meensuruti in Ariyalur district. More than 50 students are studying here. Pushpavalli is the headmistress of this school. Also, Ilmati is working as a catering organizer, Saraswati as a cook and Sabitha as a cooking assistant. Yesterday as usual students were given tamarind rice and eggs for lunch. After eating this, the students vomited and fainted.

### Hospital treatment

Parents and members of the public gathered in front of the school after learning about it. Later, 25 students including Avinash, Leeroshan and Mithran were admitted to Jayangondam Government Hospital by 108 Ambulance. Meensuruti Police Inspector Bhaskar who got information about this rushed to the spot. Then he took 10 students in his vehicle and admitted them to Jayangondam Government Hospital. Doctors treated them there. According to the doctors, due to food allergy, vomiting and fainting occurred in the students. They were treated accordingly. Then they returned home. The police and education authorities are investigating the incident.
