Title:	95 sick another contaminated water disaster in Raichur, Karnataka

After the Kavadiharhatti disaster in Chitradurga, an incident has now taken place in Lingasugur in Raichur district where more than 95 people fell ill after drinking contaminated water and were admitted to the hospital.

The cause of the incident is said to be sewage water in Chittapura village of the taluk. Three or four people in every house of the village who drank this water are suffering from vomiting and dysentery. More than 95 people fell ill and are being treated at Public Hospital Anehosur, Lingasugur Government Hospital.

A temporary treatment center has already been started in the village. 31 people have already recovered. However, the number of sick people is increasing. Village members have taken up cleanliness drive in their wards. Anganwadi and Asha workers have started house to house survey work.
