At least ten people, including a few children, fell ill at Jamiguda village under Pedabayalu mandal in ASR district after consuming poisonous mushrooms. The officials of the ASR district said that the group of tribal people were admitted to the government hospital at Paderu on Monday morning after they complained of stomach ache and started vomiting. They were availing treatment in the hospital. Later, doctors treating them, informed that they are in stable condition. Locals said that every year, people, mostly from the remote villages of ASR district either fall sick or die after consuming wild mushrooms.
