Worms were found in the food prepared for the students at Adarsha School in HD Kote on Monday. Students who consumed the food fell ill and were admitted to HD Kote Government Hospital. Students of 6th standard had consumed the food. They observed worms in the meal and started vomiting. The school staff immediately stopped the distribution of food to other students.

Two students, Sujatha and Abraham fell severely ill and were admitted to KR Hospital in Mysuru. Remaining children were given treatment at the Government Hospital and sent home. Parents who visited the hospital took a dig at the school administration and the officials of Akshara Dasoha. Taluk hospital medical officer Dr Bhaskar, Dr Ravi Kumar and staff visited the school and inspected the food grains. They found the dal was stale and seized the grains and sent it to the lab for tests. Zilla Panchayat president Parimala Shyam visited the hospital and enquired about the health of the students. She instructed the taluk administration and education department to take action against those who are the reason behind the incident. She questioned the assistant director of Akshara Dasoha Siddaraju and headmaster of
