Seven members of a family, including six children, were taken ill on Friday after they had consumed infected boiled milk. Once the vessel was emptied out, a dead lizard was found in it that had apparently been boiled with the milk. The incident took place at Deepanagala village under jurisdiction of Gunnaur police station in Sambhal district. All the seven were rushed to the community health centre.

There they were administered medicines and discharged after some time. Villager Sarvesh Kumar said his wife Sheela had boiled the milk in which a lizard must have fallen without anyone noticing it. She served the milk to all her six children and also consumed the same herself. Soon after, all of them started feeling unwell and began vomiting. "I couldn't understand what had gone wrong. When I checked the kitchen, I found a lizard in the milk pot. I immediately rushed them to the CHC where doctors administered them medicines and kept them under observation for two hours," Kumar said. After the doctors were satisfied with their improvement, all seven members were discharged.
