

In a village in Kishni police station area of Mainpuri district of Uttar Pradesh, people who had come to eat food at a wedding suddenly deteriorated. About 100 people started vomiting, out of which about 60 people were admitted to the hospital. In the night itself, the CMO, SDM and CO inquired about the well being of the sick people.

The marriage of Shyamveer, son of Munnalal Jatav, resident of Nandpur Manigaon in Kishni police station area, was fixed from Mohalla Surajpur Bidhuna district Auraiya. Shyamveer's procession was to be held on Monday, for which food was prepared for the pavilion's feast on Sunday.

People and relatives of Nandpur and surrounding villages ate food on Sunday evening. After 9 pm, many people started vomiting and abdominal pain. Due to which there was a stir in the village. Police was informed when the health of more people deteriorated. On which many ambulances reached the village from CHC.

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Around 12 people were admitted to PHC Kusmara and 48 people to CHC Kishni by ambulance. In view of the seriousness of the matter, ambulances were also called from Beaver. The team of health workers along with Dr. Ajay Bhadauria, the superintendent in charge of the CHC, gave everyone the necessary medicines after drinking ORS solution.

On information, SDM Kishni Jaiprakash, CO Bhogaon Chandrakesh Singh and SHO Dharmendra Kumar, Principal Representative Gagan Yadav also reached the hospital and took information from the patients. In the night itself, CMO Dr. PP Singh reached the hospital and talked to the sick people.

CMO Dr. PP Singh has told everyone's condition is out of danger. He told that due to the early preparation of food in the scorching heat, people's health has deteriorated after eating food in the evening. Mildly ill people were sent home after first aid. Till late night, many villagers were admitted to the CHC.

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
