The suspected patient was sent to District Hospital on Saturday has been identified as 32 year old truck driver from Ramnagar, Supela With seasonal diseases potential patient of jaundice and dengue have also started coming up in the twin city. For the proper treatment patients are referred to district hospital. Lal Bahadur Shashtri Hospital is the major govt. hospital in Bhilai. Here patients not only come from Bhilai city but also from Charoda and Jamul. Dengue patients also suspected from Sector, Khursipara and other areas are also admitted in LBS Government Hospital.

Doctors look after the suspected patients and then referee them to the District Hospital for further treatment. Doctors of the hospital said that till date 9 to 10 patients came for the treatment but there was only one such patient who was suspected of suffering from dengue and rest were suffering from viral fever. We have sent that patient to District Hospital for further treatment. His N1H1 report has come positive. His sample has been sent to Mekahara Raipur the report is suspected to come on Monday. Earlier two more patients' samples have been sent to Raipur and reports are likely to come on Monday.

The suspected patient was sent to District Hospital on Saturday has been identified as 32 year old truck driver from Ramnagar, Supela. As per information the patient on July 19 went to Hyderabad in truck to deliver goods. There he fall ill and after returning Bhilai he got his checkup done. During kit test his N1H1 report came positive and taking sample it has been sent to Raipur for ELISA test. From July 1 to till date around 37 suspected cases of dengue has been detected of which seven cases has been diagnosed positive.
