The residents of Karnataka's Raichur city were infuriated after one person died and 62 other people including 23 children were hospitalised after consuming water which was reportedly contaminated.

Dr Bhaskar, the Superintendent of the Raichur Institute of Medical Sciences (RIMS), stated on Tuesday that 62 people were taken to the hospital due to dehydration as a result of vomiting and diarrhoea.

Mallamma, a 40-year-old Indiranagar resident, died of a serious illness on May 29, and 31 people were hospitalised.

The number of people hospitalised due to contamination of water increased to 62 on Tuesday, news agency IANS reported.

Residents of Raichur have expressed their dissatisfaction with the city's administration for failing to provide safe drinking water.

Locals also indicate that residents are becoming ill in the wards after they drank water supplied from the Rampuru Reservoir, IANS reported.

They pointed out that, despite the state government's efforts to secure the availability of safe drinking water, the corporation had provided tainted water.

Residents also claimed that the district administration had failed to reply to their appeals.
