

About 100 students of Snehodaya College of Nursing, at Aloor near Mala, are under observation following suspected food poisoning. The incident happened on January 26 and 27. All the affected students are inmates of the college hostel. The condition of most of them are reported to be not serious, though one student was hospitalized, but discharged soon. However, some students are still showing mild symptoms like stomach ache and diarrhoea, said college authorities.

The health inspector in the area Subramanian said the samples collected from the affected students were sent for analysis to Thrissur medical college, and the results were awaited. He said food safety officials have also sent the samples for testing.

98 students seek treatment in Wayanad

As many as 98 students of the Jawahar Navodaya Vidhyalaya at Pookode in Wayanad sought treatment after they developed vomiting and stomach ache. Later, an expert team from the health department visited the residential school and intensified preventive measures.
