

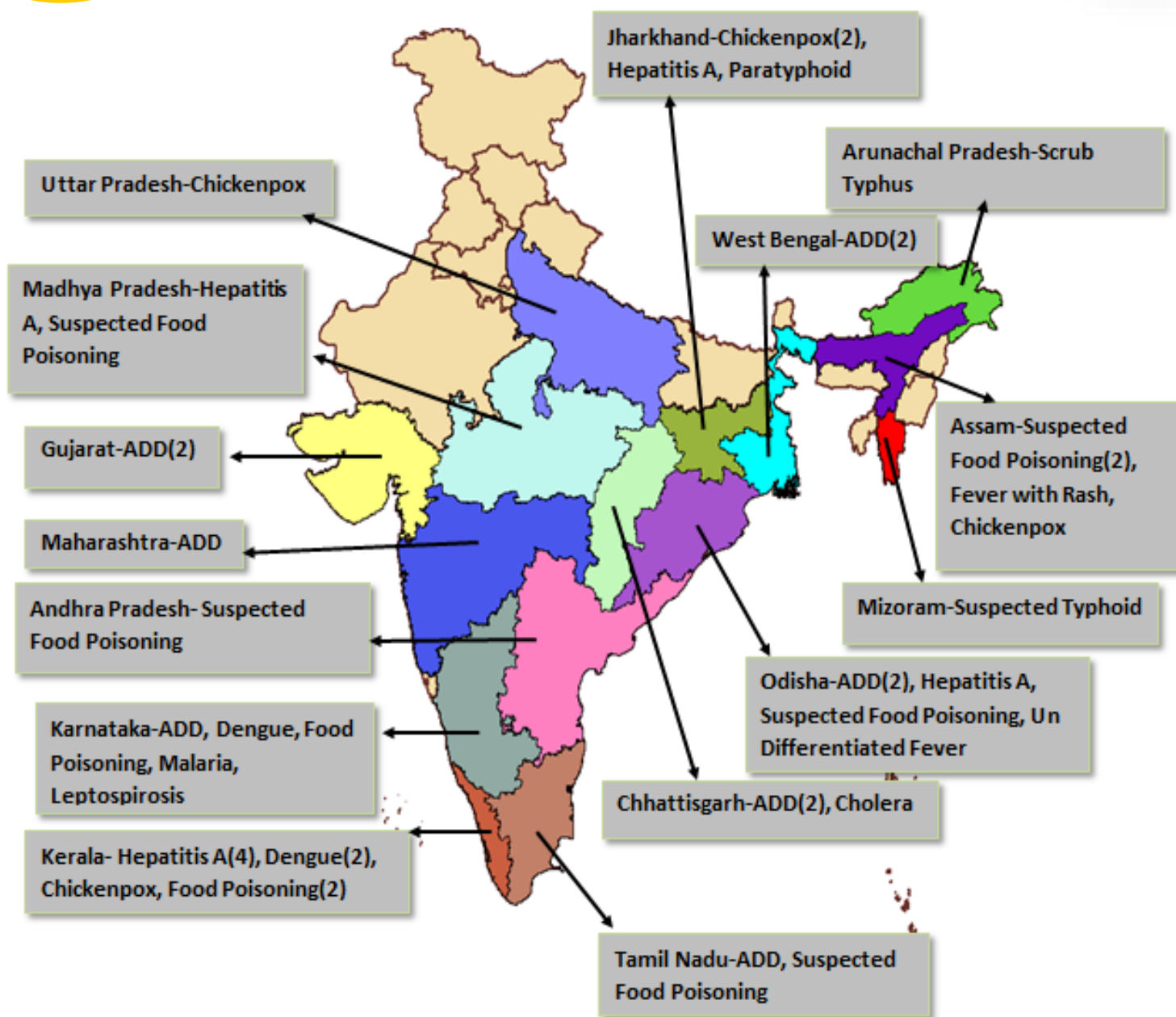

25th Week Map

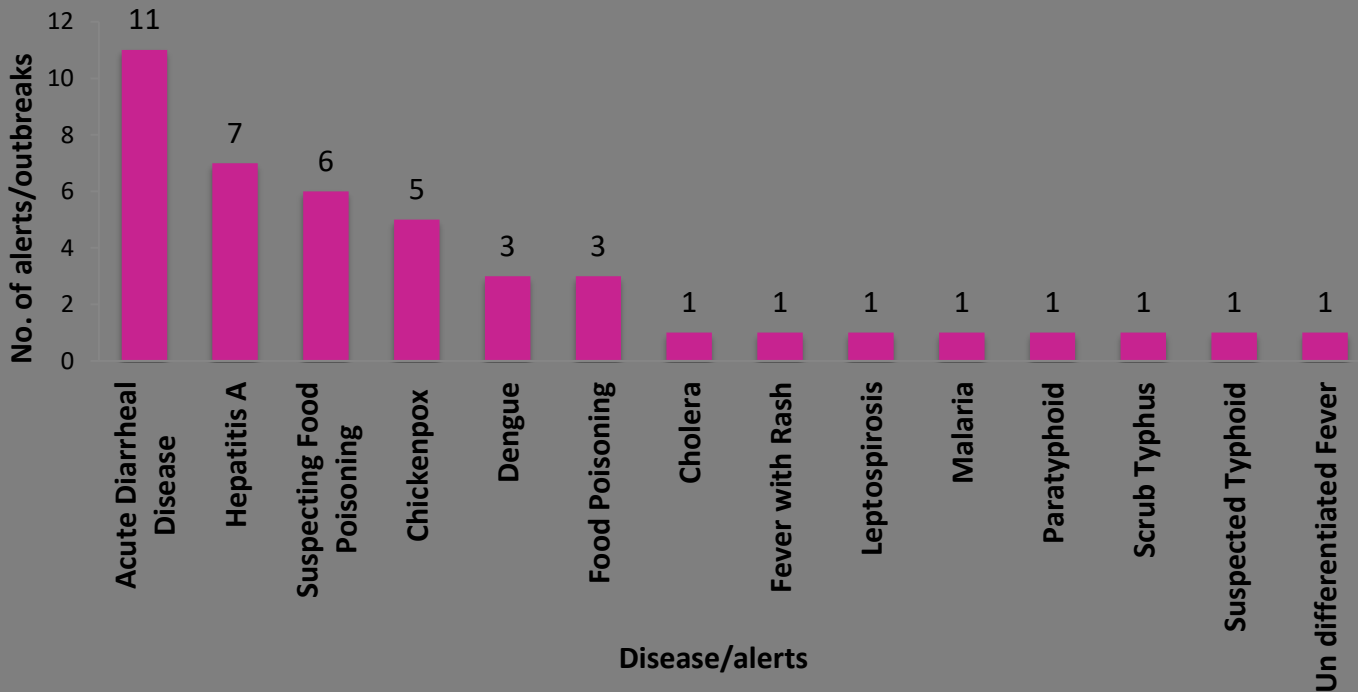
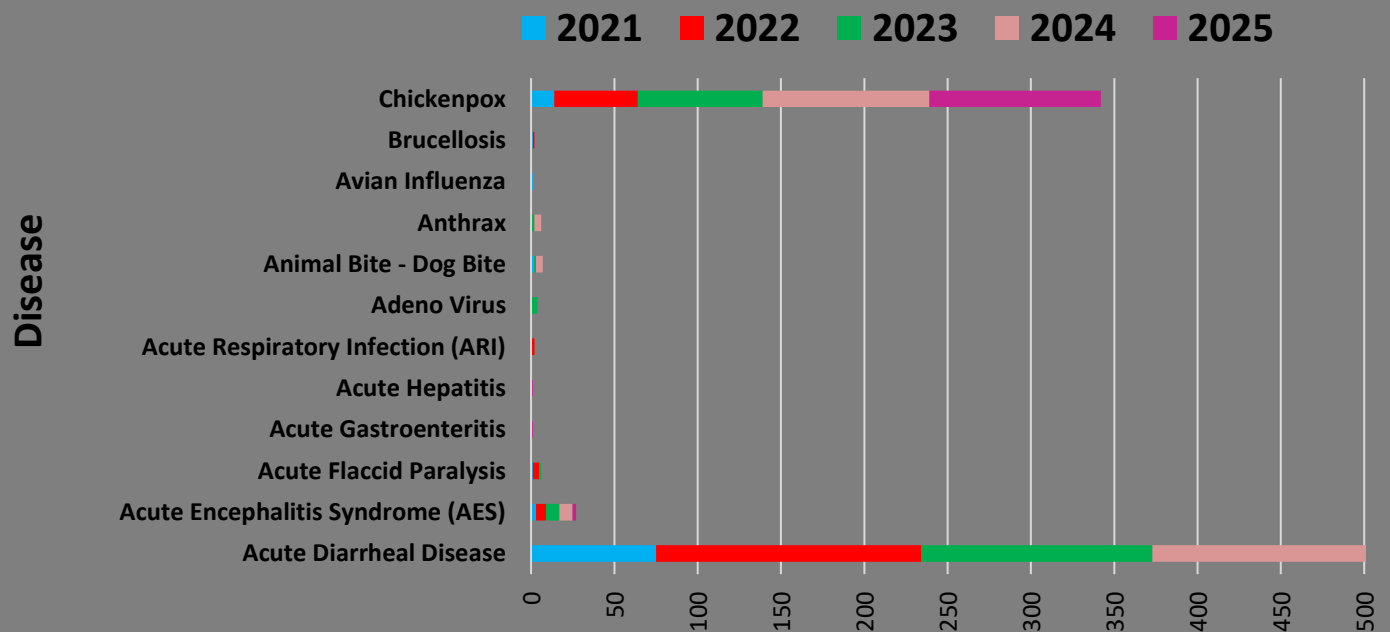

All affected individuals received treatment including ORS, zinc, and medications, while severe cases were referred to higher health facilities with ambulance support.
