Around 15 people who had breakfast in a hotel in Kuruvihalli village in Sirguppa taluk, fell ill and were hospitalised after complaining of vomiting and diarrhoea.

According to sources, three of the 15 were children. After having breakfast in that hotel, many began to complain of stomach pain and a few had loose motions.

Dr. Janardhan, the District Health Officer, told Hubli Express that he had dispatched a team led by a Taluka Health Officer to the site to investigate and submit a report. The DHO stated that he did not receive a precise figure of how many people became ill, but that once the THO spoke with him, he would announce the figures.

The local people said that customers who fell ill ate Idli in their breakfast. Few were admitted to a primary health centre and few were shifted to Government Hospital in Sirguppa.
