Around 100 of the 600-odd trainee constables at the Police Training Centre in Dhule complained of stomach ache, vomiting and nausea after having dinner at the mess of the facility on Friday.

The trainee constables were taken to the Dhule medical college and hospital by late Friday evening. "Twenty-seven of them were admitted to the hospital for observation. The trainee constables were administered saline and antibiotics. By Saturday afternoon, 20 of the trainee constables were sent back to the training centre. Seven of them are still recuperating," Arun More, acting-dean of the medical college, said on Saturday evening.

Dhule superintendent of police Pravin Patil said the condition of the cadets was stable. The Dhule city police initiated an investigation to find out what had triggered the health complications among the cadets. An official at the training centre said the food served was decided by the trainee constables.

More said, "It appears that the cadets suffered from food poisoning. Officials at the police training centre have sent the food samples for testing. Many times, immunity plays an important role owing to which some people suffer problems related to digestion and food poisoning and some do not."
