Title:	15 people fell ill after consuming sweets in Durga Puja fair, two including father and son died in Arwal, Bihar

During Durga Puja in Bihar, 15 people suddenly fell ill after consuming toxic sweets from a shop in the fair. Two people have died in this incident. With the help of the villagers, all were admitted to the Sadar Hospital for treatment. The incident is of Rohai village under Karpi police station area of Arwal district. All the sick children are residents of Keshwar Bigha, Bajitpur and Bara villages of Karpi police station area. All the children had gone to visit the fair in Durga Puja. During this, everyone had eaten sweets and bread from the shop in the market.

After visiting the fair, everyone went home. During this, suddenly his health deteriorated in the night, after which all the children were brought to Sadar Hospital for treatment. All the children are being treated by the doctors. In this incident, Babulal Bhim and his son Gautam Kumar, resident of Etawa village, have died due to food poisoning. It was told by the treating doctor posted at Sadar Hospital that after being a victim of food poisoning, all the people have been admitted to the Sadar Hospital for treatment, in which there are 9 small children.

There are also some women and men among the sick who are being treated. He told that all will be recovered within 24 hours. These days in the market, if such waste material is used by the shopkeeper in the food items, then it can lead to great negligence. Aniruddha Das, the

relatives of the victims said that the children had gone to visit the fair. During this, he ate bread and some sweets on a handcart, after which vomiting started late in the night as soon as he reached home.

After vomiting, the children were admitted to Karpi Primary Health Center where doctors referred them to Sadar Hospital for better treatment. The victim told that when the children were questioned, they told that their health had deteriorated due to eating food items in the fair.
