Title:	Three died, 29 vomiting and diarrhea in Tikamgarh, Madhya Pradesh

Three people have died due to vomiting and diarrhea spread after the meal of village Chandrapura thirteenth in Jatara block, while more than one hundred people are said to be ill. Out of these people, 15 of these people have been admitted to Community Health Center and 14 to the district hospital. However, the health department is talking about no death due to vomiting. After eating here, the health of the people started deteriorating. After this, many people started vomiting diarrhea. When this problem is bigger from August 16, people got noticed it. After this, people got their treatment at the local level, but to no avail. On August 18, Chintoli dynasty 73 years, Gariba Pal 80 years and Manisha Saun 14 years died of vomiting diarrhea. It is being told that he died of vomiting and diarrhea. However, the Health Department is clearly denying this. CMHO Dr. PK Mahore says that while Manisha Saunr died of snake bite, Chintoli died of gastrointhritis and Gariba due to chronic TB and sugar disease.

CMO-BMO In the matter, the Health Department seems to be hiding the truth about diarrhea spread after vomiting and diarrhea in the contamination. In this case, while the CMs have issued a letter on behalf of the department, they have said that no one died due to vomiting and diarrhea. Along with this, the villagers also believed that due to lack of proper

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drinking water in the village, many people had started having vomiting and diarrhea before the thirteenth. At the same time, after the thirteenth, this problem suddenly increased.

14 patients have been admitted to the district hospital from the same treatment. In this, Harishchandra Prajapati 32, Malkhan Adivasi 30, Damodar Adivasi 16, Bharat Pal 30, Mukundi Adivasi 22, Sanjay Adivasi 14, Rachna Pal 25, Munnibai Pal 60, Komal Pal 40, Shantibai Pal 35 are being treated. At the same time, Rampyari Pal is being admitted to ICU on 50 years and treatment is being done.

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
