

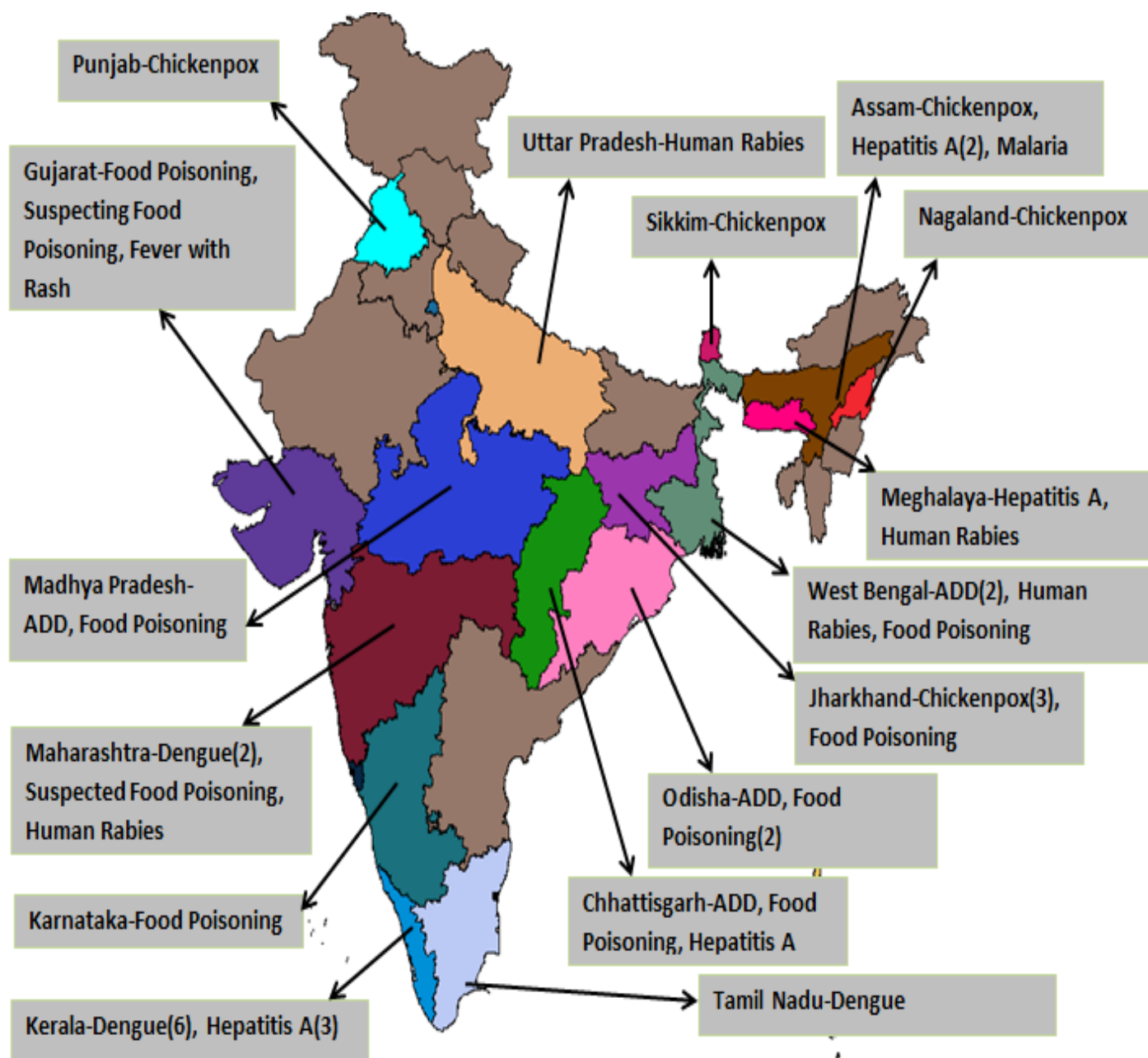

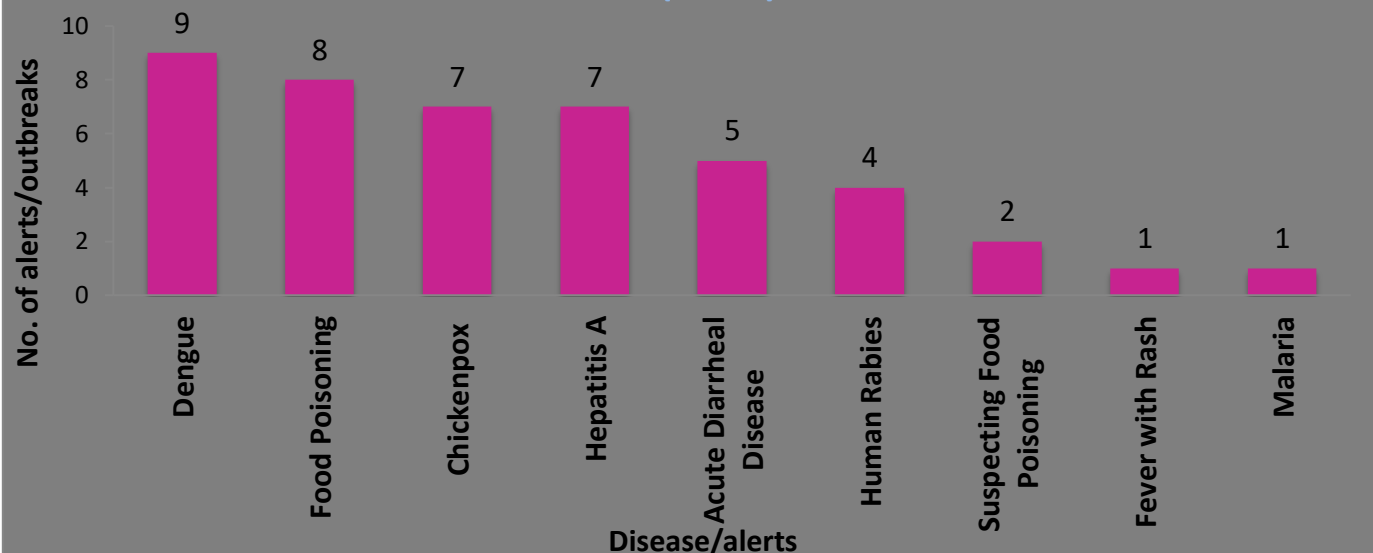

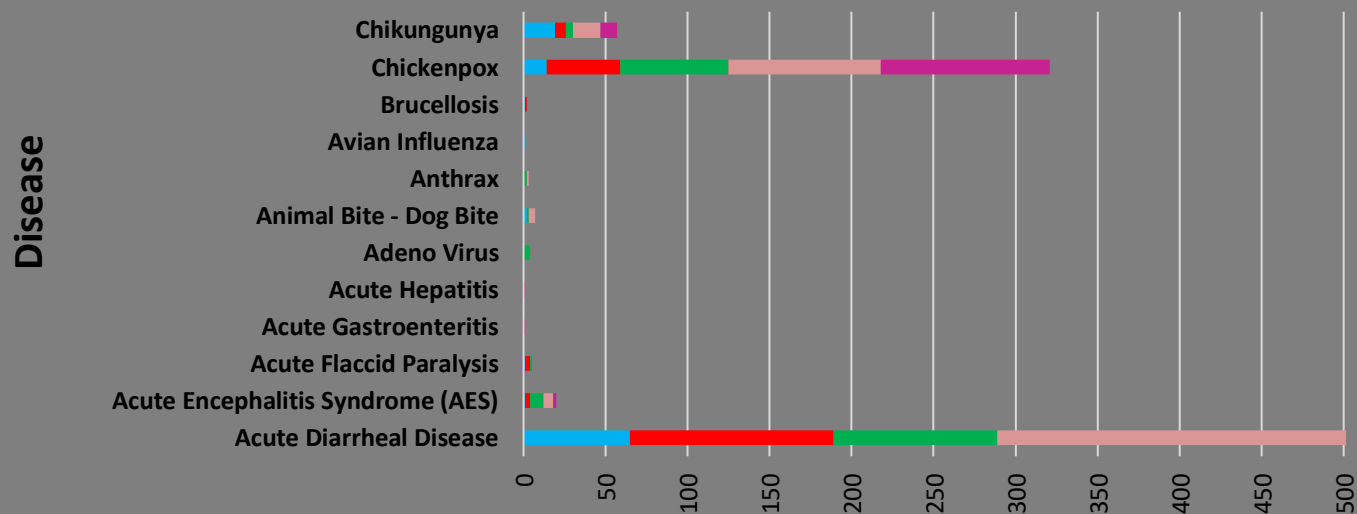

Community awareness and health education given by peripheral team on control measures, hygiene and sanitation. Death of a 10 year old girl had occur due to suspected Rabies.

IEC activities, including a public health awareness campaign, were conducted in the local language with the involvement of the local headman, focusing on rabies prevention, timely reporting, and the importance of seeking medical care after animal bites. The patient succumbed to death on 28th May 2025.

The 33 year old male presented with muscle spasms, confusion, vomiting, hydrophobia and aerophobia. There is history of dog bite one month back. The case was clinically diagnosed as rabies. The patient did not receive post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP) and succumbed to the illness on May 24, 2025. Close contacts including family members were identified and instructed to take anti-rabies vaccine. IEC activities to educate the community on rabies prevention, importance of timely vaccination was done. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Community awareness and health education given by peripheral team on control measures, hygiene and sanitation.
