

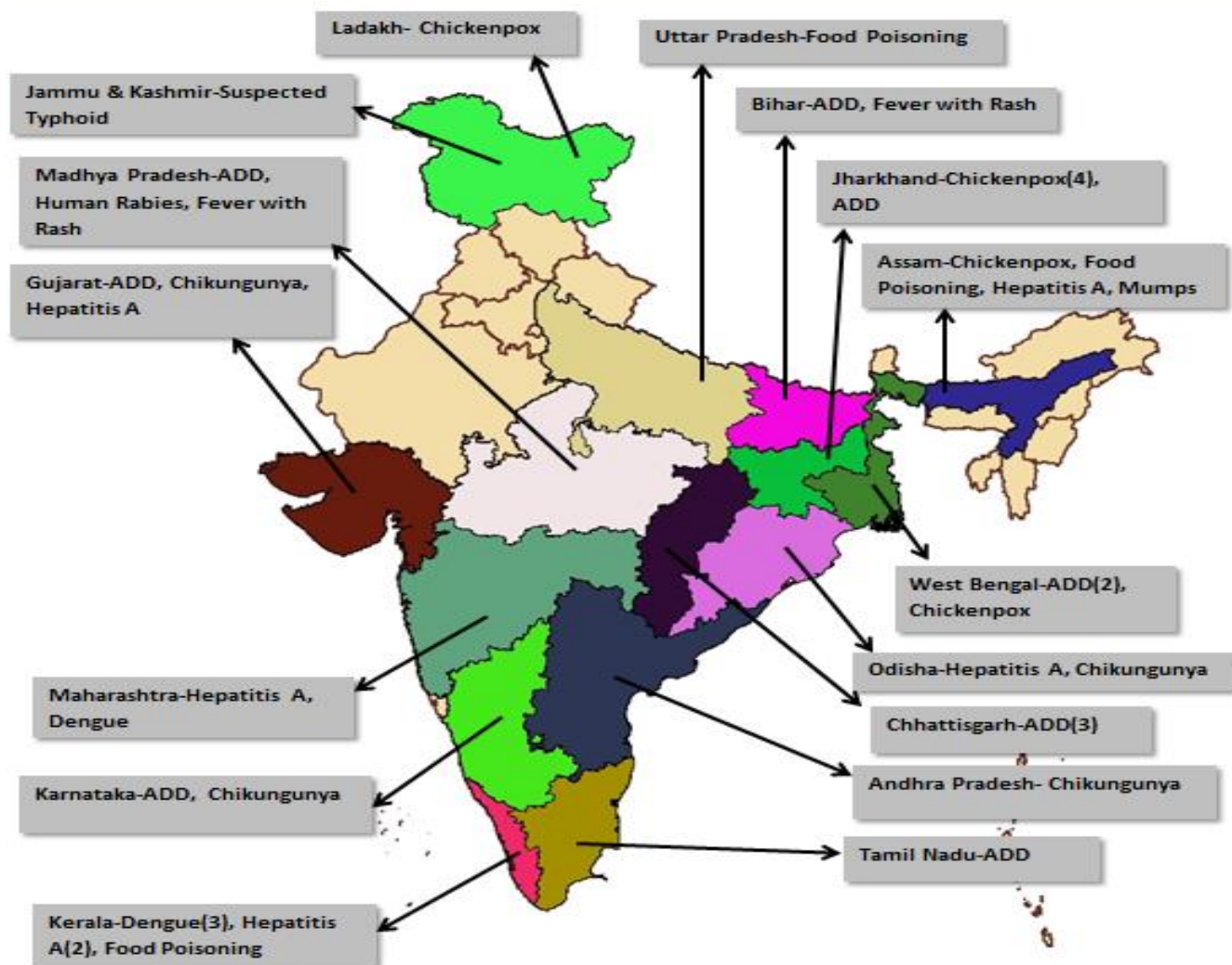

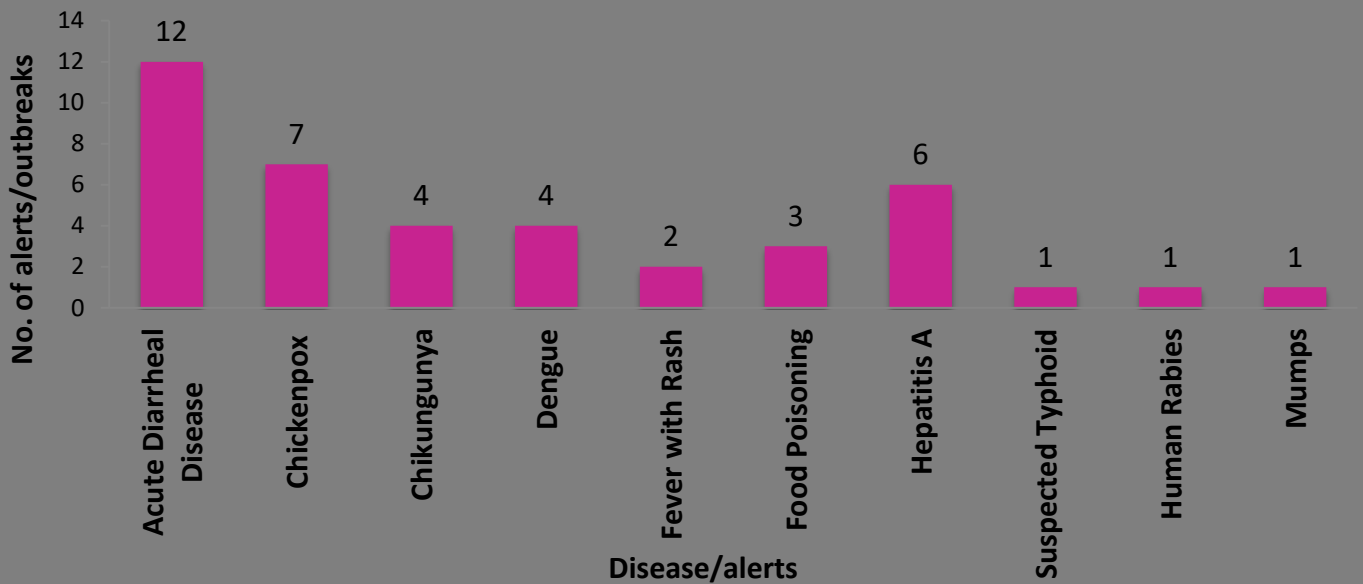

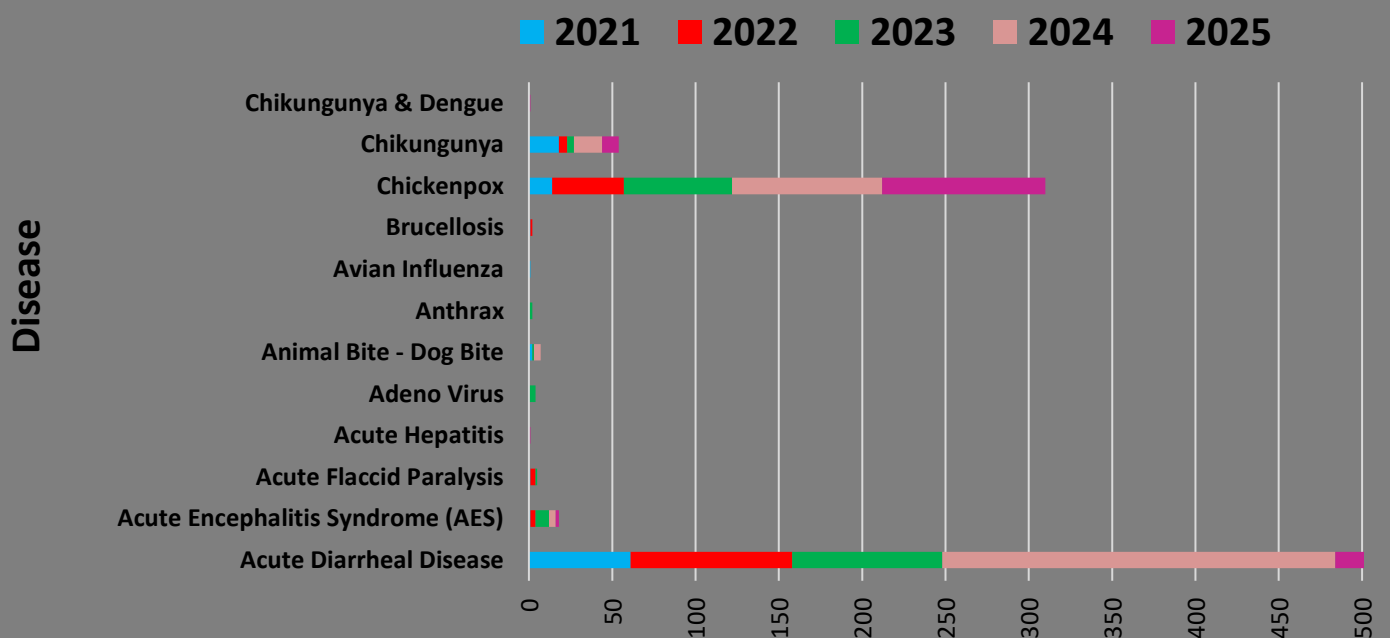

Cases presented with symptoms of Yellowish coloration of the eyes, fever, and nausea. 26 blood samples and 7 water samples were collected and sent to DPHL Golaghat and SKK Civil Hospital. 11 samples found Hepatitis A positive by ELISA. 2 Water samples found unfit for potable purpose. District RRT investigated the outbreak. The main cause of outbreak is contaminated water supply. Cases treated symptomatically. A 21-year-old male expired on 21-05-2025. Community awareness and health education given by peripheral team on hygiene and sanitation. |
