Title:	Seven people fell sick after chlorine gas leaks in Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh

Seven people have been injured due to a chlorine gas leak from a cylinder at a water filtration plant in Bhopal.

Assistant Commissioner of Police, Shahjanabad, Umesh Mishra said that a 900-kg chlorine cylinder had leaked at the Bhopal Corporation's water treatment plant in Idka Hills on Wednesday.

As a result, 7 people living near the plant have been admitted to the hospital due to health problems. After the gas leak, people there reported suffocation, coughing and vomiting.

After a gas leak was noticed, the cylinder was thrown into the water at the distillation plant. He also said that the fault in the plant has been rectified.

Earlier, in December 1984, thousands of people were killed and more than five lakh were injured after inhaling toxic fumes from the defunct Union Carbide plant.
