Title:	15 girl students fall ill after eating stale food in Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh

In Lucknow, the capital of Uttar Pradesh, at least 15 girls of the Government Ashram system of girls' school fell ill on Saturday. In such a situation, the girl students have been immediately admitted to Lokbandhu Hospital on complaints of abdominal pain, vomiting and nervousness. Due to this, other angry students came on the road at 10 pm. During this, the girl students blocked Budheshwar square, accusing them of being given bad food. Where the girls were raising slogans against the local district administration.

Actually, this case is of Alambagh area of capital Lucknow. According to the police officials, the agitated girl students allege that even after complaining they are being given useless and stale food. On getting information about the performance of the girl students, the top officials of the police and local district administration reached the spot. At the same time, after about 3 hours, the girl students ended their dharna at 10 o'clock in the night. During this, the students of Jyotiba Rao Phule College had also come to support about 150 girl students who were protesting.
