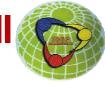

In Assam, at-least forty one students fell ill after consuming a mid-day meal at Baruahola High School in Tinsukia district.				
According to sources, the meal was prepared by an NGO which have been blacklisted by the New Delhi government.				
After the incident occurred the students were rushed to Tinsukia Civil Hospital.				
It is to be mention that the NGO named Ghanashyam Seva Samiti, has been blacklisted by the New Delhi government after delivering meals containing worms.				
Meanwhile, protests are erupting in different parts of the state by body of cooks and helpers after the government handed out the Midday Meal Scheme to NGOs.
