Tamil Nadu recorded 2,485 cases of dengue since January but there have been no deaths due to the viral infection, health minister Ma Subramanian said here on Monday.				
The state tested more than two lakh people between January and May and all those infected were treated at various hospitals as per standard protocol, he said after flagging off a mosquito fogging machine on National Dengue Day at the Government Multi-specialty Hospital on Monday. "There were no deaths due to vector-borne disease this year. I hope we record none," he said. The state has launched a drive to stop breeding of mosquitoes by preventing water stagnation, he said. tnn
