Title:	30 students in Kuppam hostel fell ill in district Chittoor, Andhra Pradesh

At least 30 girl students staying in Akkamahadevi women's hostel of Dravidian University in Kuppam were hospitalised on Tuesday after they complained of vomiting and diarrhoea, which doctors said could be due to food poisoning.

After the students fell ill, the university informed medical authorities and rushed them to a hospital in Kuppam for treatment. Sources said 30 girl students of PG college hostel were brought to the hospital with symptoms of vomiting and diarrhoea. According to sources, local medical authorities have been informed about the development. Food samples were collected to confirm or rule out the possibility of food poisoning. All the students are out of danger, sources said.

Meanwhile, TDP chief and Kuppam MLA Chandrababu Naidu enquired into the incident and asked his local party activists to ensure the best care is provided to the students.
