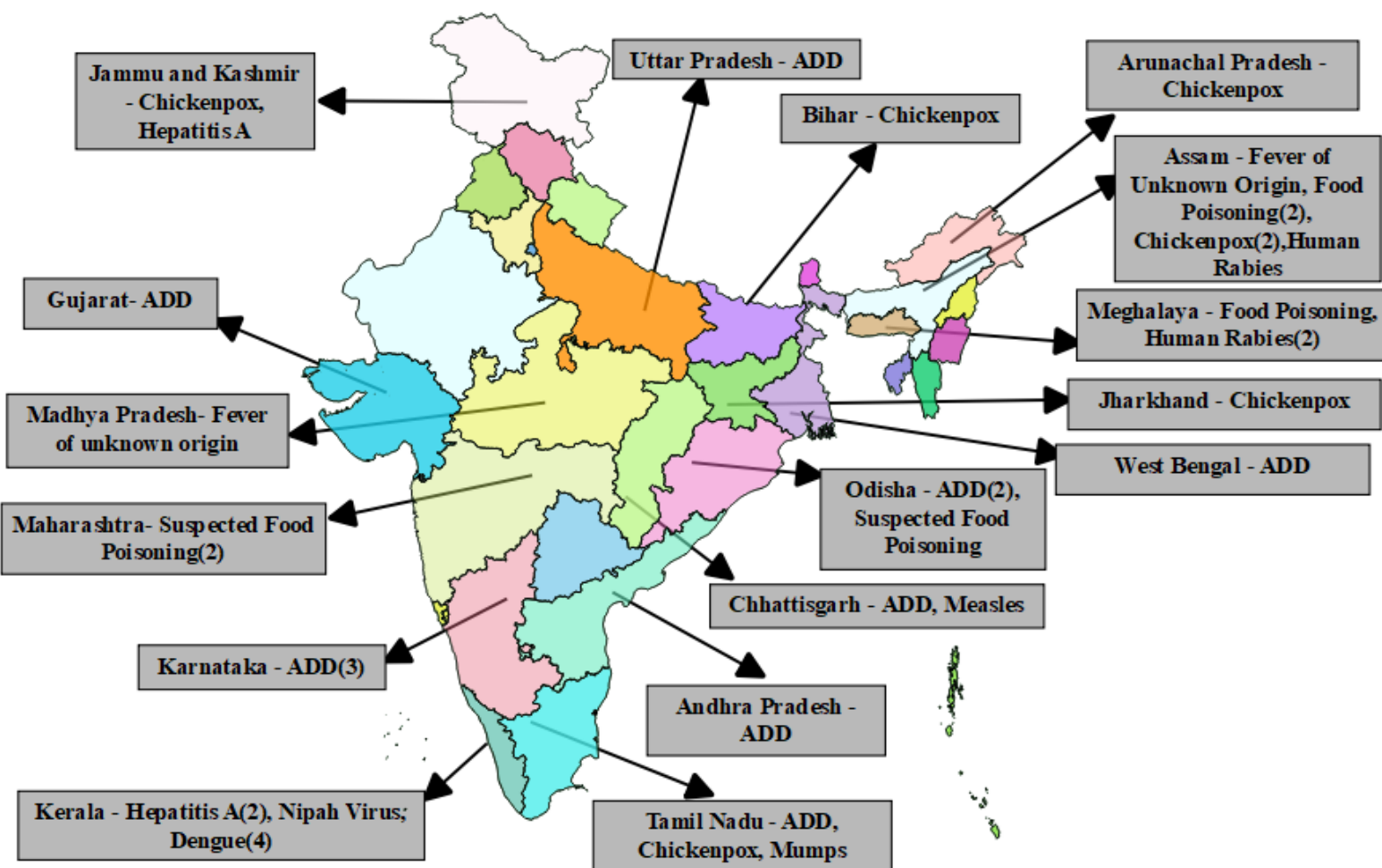

19th Week Map

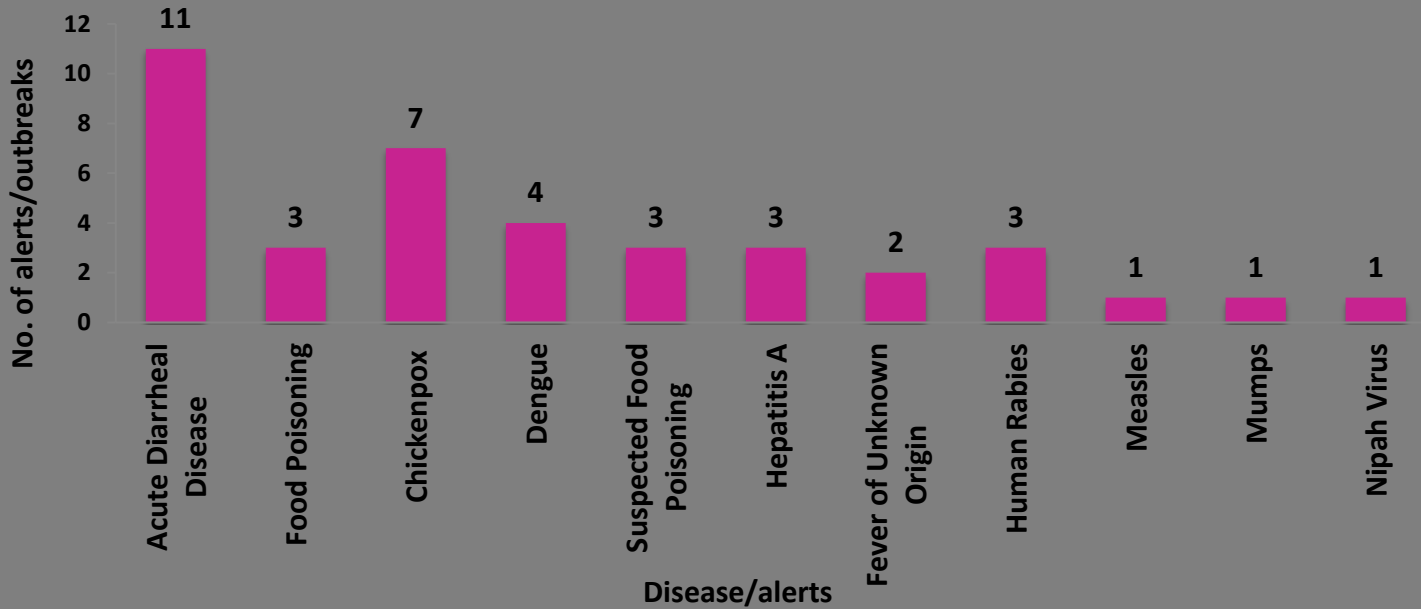
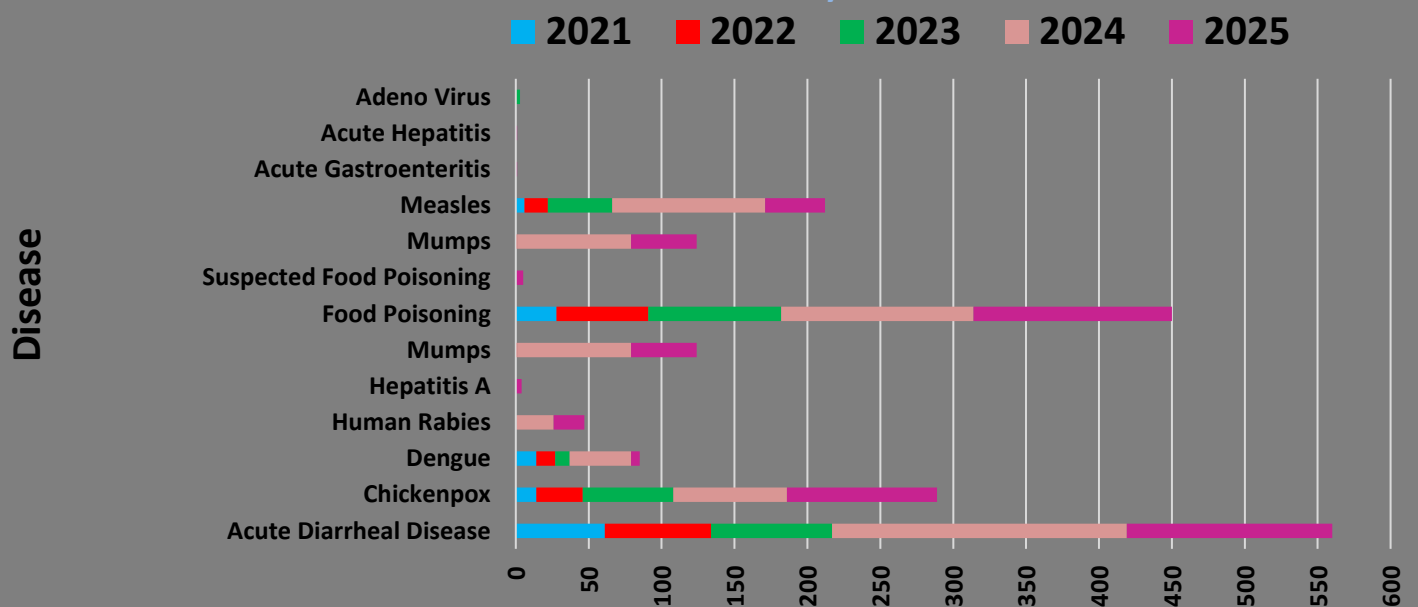
