



27<sup>th</sup> Week Map




A total of 03 water samples collected and sent to DPHL and reported as appears normal. Valve leakages were repaired. All cases treated. Instructions given to regularly chlorinate water. Health education given.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house survey conducted. Cases presented with loose stool, vomiting and pain abdomen after consuming food in a social gathering.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house survey conducted. Contamination of drinking water source was observed. A total of 02 stool and 02 water samples collected and sent to Thanjavur Medical College and DPHL Khumbakonam respectively. The 02 stool samples showed growth of E.coli and both water samples were found positive for coliform organisms. All cases treated. Alternated water supply arranged. Health education given.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. State and District NVBDCP officials were informed. House to house survey conducted. Paddy fields and pigs were found in the affected area. The deceased was a 50Y/F, had presented with fever and altered mental status. A total of 40 blood smears were collected and found to be negative for Malaria. A total of 02 CSF samples collected and sent to GMCH were found to positive for Japanese Encephalitis by IgM ELISA. All cases treated. Fogging done. Health education given.
