Two students of a private residential school in Igatpuri for mentally challenged and physically disabled children died reportedly from food poisoning on Wednesday morning.

The students have been identified as Mohammad Juber Shaikh (9) of Nashik city and Harhal Bhoer (23) of Bhiwandi, Thane.

Superintendent of police (Nashik rural) Sachin Patil said they have registered a case of accidental death. Patil went to Igatpuri and the Nashik civil hospital to enquire about the health of the other students.

"Seven more students have taken ill after the dinner they had in the school on Tuesday. Two of them have been admitted to the Nashik civil hospital and five at the Igatpuri rural hospital," said district health officer Kapil Aher, who sent a team to the school to check on the health of the other students.

Additional district health officer Yeoraj Deore said the students who have been admitted to hospital as well as the remaining 84 are stable. He said they had eaten khichadi for dinner.
