<ul> <li>At least 17 children were admitted to a hospital in Tamil Nadu's Cuddalore district on Monday after they consumed a mid-day meal at an anganwadi.</li> <li>Children who ate food at an anganwadi in Poodhangati village began to vomit and faint. They were rushed to the Cuddalore Government Hospital.</li> <li>Parents also alleged that there was a dead lizard in the food which turned it poisonous.</li> <li>District Collector K Balasubramaniam reached the hospital and spoke to the parents. Two children had to be given drips while others were out of danger, he said.</li> <li>"Food safety officers and other officials are conducting an investigation based on which action would be taken against those responsible," K Balasubramaniam said.</li> <li>As per Covid-19 relaxations, the mid-day meal scheme was re-initiated in anganwadis across</li> </ul>				
the state from September 1.
