Title:	Rajasthan logs 5 swine flu deaths in 9 days, 3 in Jaipur

In nine days, the state reported five swine flu deaths, three in Jaipur, while one each in Dholpur and Tonk. The state reported six swine flu deaths in 2022, out of those five happened in June. Besides, 13 persons were tested positive for the virus in nine days.

Health department officials said that the number of swine flu cases rose to 105 in 2022 (from January 1 to June 8). In Jaipur, four deaths have been reported due to swine flu in 2022, out of those three deaths took place in June. "The deaths which were reported in the city, were all elderly people with comorbidities," said Dr Narrottam Sharma, chief medical and health officer, Jaipur (I).

Dr Sharma said that the situation is not alarming as sporadic cases of swine flu are being reported. "However, we have alerted our doctors in the district on swine flu and to conduct screening of suspected swine flu cases," said Dr Sharma.

In 2022 (from January 1 to June 8), 638 samples were tested for swine flu, out of those 105 have tested positive for the virus and 533 persons tested negative for swine flu. In nine days (from June 1 to June 9), 108 samples were tested for swine flu, out of those 14 have tested positive for the virus and 94 persons tested negative for swine flu.
