A 52-year-old woman from Jalore and a 40-year-old woman from Jodhpur died of swine flu in the past two days.

According to health department officials, the woman from Chand Pole area of Jodhpur was suffering from cold, cough and fever for the last 10 days. When her condition deteriorated, she was rushed to a private hospital in Ahmedabad where she succumbed to the disease on Tuesday night.

The 52-year-old woman, who was brought to Jodhpur for treatment from Jalore, died of swine flu on Monday. They both were tested positive for the disease.

Health authorities claimed that they had started surveillance of the areas in which the women lived.

Rajasthan is at the top of the list of states having the highest number of swine flu cases this year till September 22. It ranks No. 2 after Maharashtra in swine flu deaths.

स्वच्छ भारत एक कदम स्वच्छता की ओर According to the National Centre for Disease Control report, the state has reported 5,076 cases and 206 deaths due to swine flu in 2018. Maharashtra reported 229 deaths and 2,223 cases of swine flu from January 1 till September 22.

Informing about the preparedness to deal with the disease, health minister Raghu Sharma said that they had made available Tamiflu tablets even in all the 14,000 subcentres. He said that they had also sounded an alert on swine flu and other seasonal diseases.

In the past one month, at least 32 persons have diagnosed with swine flu across the state. Till August 22, 5,043 persons were diagnosed with swine flu, which increased to 5,078 on September 24.
