

47th Week Map




KL/KOZ/2020/47/477	Kerala	Kozhikode	Food Poisoning	300	00	18-11-20	19-11-20	Under Control	Cases reported from Village Pashukadavu, Maruthomkara, Koyhod, Adukkath, HSC Maruthomkara, PHC/Block Pashukadavu. 438 persons reported with the symptoms of vomiting, abdominal pain and diarrhea. All affected cases were treated symptomatically at various hospitals with antibiotics and ORS. Date of onset of last case was 20/11/2020. As per the investigation suspected source was found to be chicken distributed in the Biryani Food fest event. District RRT investigated the outbreak. The RRT provided medical support by distributing medicines to symptomatic cases.
KL/CNR/2020/47/478	Kerala	Kannur	Visceral Leishmaniasis	01	00	25-10-20	18-11-20	Under Surveillance	One case was reported from Village Aralam, HSC Aralam, PHC Aralam Farm, Block Keezhpally. Bone marrow aspiration done at Govt Medical College, Kannur shows amastigote forms of L.donovani and LD bodies, suggestive of Visceral Leishmaniasis. The patient was admitted in GMC, Kannur with the history of fever, headache, myalgia, pallor, mild icterus, bipedal edema and hepatosplenomegaly. District RRT investigated the outbreak and reviewed the situation. Entomological study was doneo sandflies were detected from the area. Insecticide residual spray conducted in dwelling houses and cattle sheds using Lamda cyhalothrin. Door to door IPC and IEC activities conducted.

MH/SIN/2020/47/479	Maharashtra	Sindhudurg (Kudal)	Leptospirosis	01	01	09-11-20	19-11-20	Under Surveillance	One Case reported from Kankavli Madhaliwadi, SC Kankavli No.1, Taluk Kankavli. The patient was a Male, 22yrs who expired on 15/11/2020 due to Leptospirosis. One blood sample collected and found positive for Leptospirosis. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Rapid survey, container survey, use of larvicides, Health education, distribution of Cap Doxycycline as chemoprophylaxis was done.
MP/SDI/2020/47/480	Madhya Pradesh	Sidhi	Food Poisoning	08	01	17-11-20	18-11-20	Under Surveillance	8 Cases were reported from Village Ladbada, Block Sihawal, Distt- Sidhi. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Administration and Health team have visited the affected area and active surveillance has been going on. The deceased patient was a male 10 years of age. Food samples collected and sent to Lab, result awaited. Health education given. No new cases were detected so far.

MG/EKH/2020/47/481	Meghalaya	East Khasi Hills	Scrub Typhus	19	02	07-11-20	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from Village Shilliang Jashar, CHC Pynursla. Block Pynursla. Both genders are affected with females being affected more (60%). All age groups affected (youngest being 8 years of age and oldest being 50 years of age) The most common symptoms exhibited by all cases are fever of unknown origin. An eschar mark was found in one case. There were two deaths, One 50 year, female with symptoms of fever, chills and nausea who expired on 9/11/2020 and a 11 year old male with symptoms of fever, chills and nausea who expired on 7/11/2020. Rapid Antigen test for COVID-19 were conducted and all were negative. 2 Nasal swabs samples were collected to rule out Influenza and H1N1. 13 serum samples were collected by Weil Felix test out of which 8 samples titration level (OXX) were significantly high. RRT investigated the outbreak. An IEC was conducted along with door to door case search and IEC.

MH/SIN/2020/47/482	Maharashtra	Sindhudurg (Kudal)	Leptospirosis	01	01	10-11-20	Under Surveillance	One Case was reported from Humarmala Domblewadi, SC Oros Br. Taluk Kudal, Dist- Sindhudurg. Patient was a 22yrs old male, date of death was 16/11/2020. One blood sample collected and One sample was positive for Leptospirosis. 18 blood samples were collected and the result is awaited. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Rapid survey, Container survey, use of larvicides, Health education and distribution of Cap Doxycycline as a chemoprophylaxis measure was done.
