Three cases of swine flu (H1N1 influenza) were reported in the district in the last couple of days around a gap of two years, showed records.

The three cases were found positive after they were rushed to a private hospital in the city with complaints of cough, high grade fever, breathlessness, showed records. Of those three cases, two were males aged 62 and 83 years. The third case is a female aged 58 years.

District in-charge Integrated Disease Surveillance programme (IDSP) Dr Amit Malakar said, “Three cases of swine flu were reported in the district this year. There were no cases in the last two years.”

In those three cases, only one 62-year-old male had a travel history to Gujarat then returning to Indore via Ujjain before being admitted to a hospital with high grade fever, cough and breathlessness on May 20. He is still in the hospital undergoing treatment, records showed.

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In the case of another 83-year-old old swine flu positive case, his daughter developed symptoms after travelling back from Ujjain but wasn't tested. Later, two other family members also developed symptoms but also not tested, said an official.

When the 83-year-old male however developed a cough, and high grade fever he was taken to hospital, where he tested positive, said official. In the case of the 58-year-old female, she hadn't any travel history either of herself or of her family members, said an official.

A swine flu case was reported after testing of samples from the government virology laboratory in Mahatma Gandhi Memorial Medical College.

The lab however, because of high occupancy of Covid-19 samples testing, could only test 221 samples of swine flu in the last two years till March first week, showed records.

In the case of Madhya Pradesh, there were only two reported cases of Swine flu in 2021 that was 99.72% less than those in the pre-pandemic year in 2019.

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
